Matt has served on the faculty of Kodály certification programs at Wichita State University, University of Central Missouri, University of California-Bakersfield, and Morehead State University. Matt has presented at the national, regional, state, and local levels on various topics relating to choral rehearsal techniques and improvisation. In July 2015, 2017, and 2018 Matt studied in Kecskemét, Hungary, at the International Kodály Seminar and summer school.

Matt is the director of music at Pleasant Valley United Methodist Church, the director of the Wichita Broadway Singers and the Ad Astra Singers, has directed honor choirs across the state of Kansas, and has served as music director for shows with Music Theatre for Young People in Wichita. He has served as the tenor section leader for the Wichita Symphony Chorus, and is often a member of the Wichita Chamber Chorale. When not at a rehearsal, Matt enjoys reading and caring for his cat, Cleo.
